These are some examples. I have also categorised 2 other conceptual typologies – wooden idiophones and frictophones (essentially ‘friction instruments’ - a new category that covers instruments that cross boundaries of material construction)

### Membranophones




### Metal Idiophones

cowbell body


(edge of cymbal/gong)

And playing rolls with brushes on the various drums would look like this.



And of course I have more articulations that are universally applicable across the range of the instruments. They also are applicable to the tuned percussion instruments where appropriate.
